July 29 2013, Szeged.

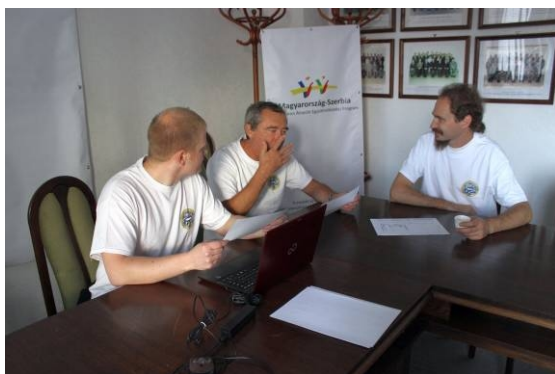
Training course entitled “Advanced training on devices” organized in the frame of Hungary – Serbia IPA Cross-border Co-operation Programme (HUSRB/1203) was conducted on 29th of July, 2013, in Szeged Regional Drug Laboratory.

The training was focused on support information on GC-MS, HPLC, FTIR analytical techniques. During the training, practical guidance about GC-MS, HPLC, FTIR devices planned to purchase was provided.

On the modern equipments, Mr. Tamás Csesztregi, Head of the Central Drug Laboratory and Dr. Tibor Veress, Head of the Regional Drug Laboratories shared their experiences and knowledge with the staff of the Regional Drug Laboratory in Szeged.

About accessories and spare parts belong to the equipments (e.g. columns, ion sources, detectors, analyzers), and manipulations with those were also discussed.

Since it is important to present how these instruments can contribute to success of analysis work (maximize chromatographic separation and optimize detection), regulations of various parameters like heating programme, pressure, flow rate, selections of columns, solvents etc. in general was also subject of the training.
