June of 28 2013, Novi Sad (Serbia)

Trip summary:

For the invitation of National Forensic Center, Ministry of Interior of the Republic of Serbia, members of the Hungarian delegation – Dr. János Lukács, Csongrád-county Main Captaincy; Mr. Tamás Csesztregi, head of Central Drug Laboratory; Mr. Balázs Tolnai, staff of Szeged Regional Drug Laboratory – participated on the Opening Event of the project entitled "Novi Sad – Szeged cross-border cooperation in development of harmonized methods and production of common database for the analysis of designer drugs". The project was selected for co-financing in the 3rd Call for Proposals of the Hungary – Serbia IPA Cross-border Co-operation Programme.

Among the project-members, more than 50 invited guests - mainly police officers, judges, prosecutors, journalists in Serbia - participated on the Opening Event held on 28th of June 2013, in Novi Sad.

The Event was opened by Mr. Marko Milivojevic, representative of Serbian Ministry of Interior, Head of Regional Forensic Division in Novi Sad and followed by Dr. János Lukács. Dr. János Lukács spoke about the importance of cross-border cooperation and appreciated the active collaboration exists in the border areas of the two countries. Dr. János Lukács emphasized the significance of highly trained staff, availability of modern analytical instruments, creation and development of analytical database in order to response the new phenomenon of designer drugs in Europe.

Finally, Ms. Marija Petrin, the project contact person in Serbia presented the aims and the contents of the project.





After the formal meeting a short get-together party was organized to initiate personal information-exchanges among the participants.














































